Read through the entire pattern before you get started.

Some decisions need to be made before cutting!

Cutting Instructions:



Block Borders: ($1\frac{3}{4}$ yards)

Cut 1 - 28" x wof

Subcut this into 20 - 2" x 28"

Cut 16 - 2" x wof

Subcut twelve strips each into 2 - 2" x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " (for a total of 24)

Subcut the other four strips into 1 - 2" x 28" each



Sashing: ($1\frac{1}{2}$ yards)

Cut 1 - $22\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof

Subcut this into 15 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $22\frac{1}{2}$ "

Cut 1 - $26\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof

Subcut this into 16 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ "



Cornerstones: ($\frac{1}{4}$ yard)

Cut 2 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof

Subcut these into a total of 20 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Make the Block Borders:

Square up your block as close to $20\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " as possible.

Sew a 2" x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " to each side of the large block.

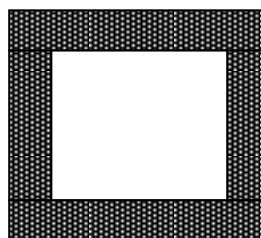
Press toward the border.



Sew a 2" x 28" to the top and bottom of the block above.

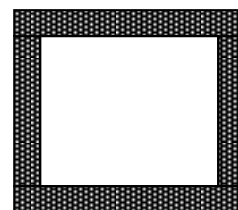
(Center the piece if it is not quite long enough or too long.)

Press toward the border.



Square your block with borders to $22\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ ", centering the block.

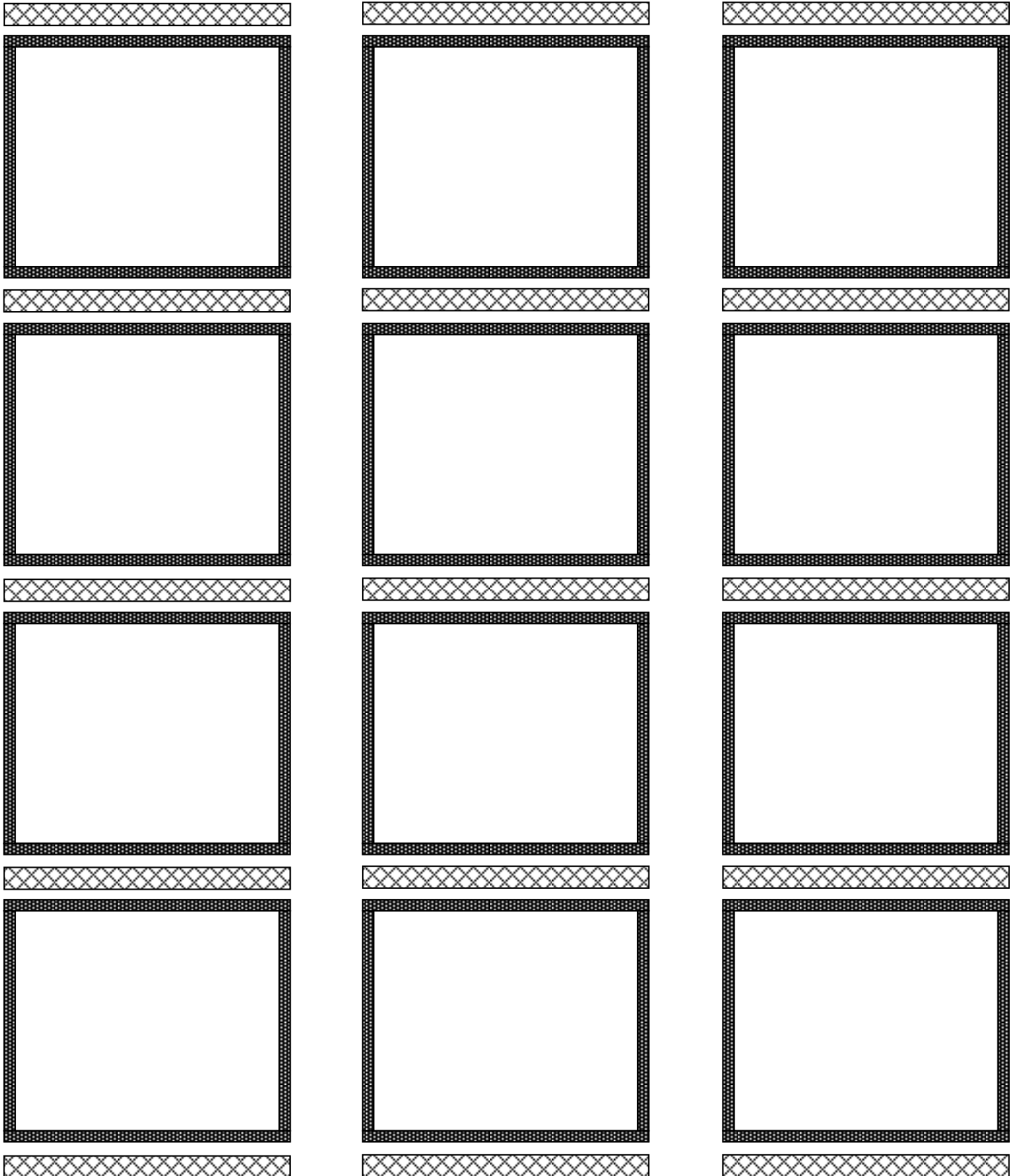
Repeat to Border the other eleven Blocks.



Lay Out the Quilt Center:

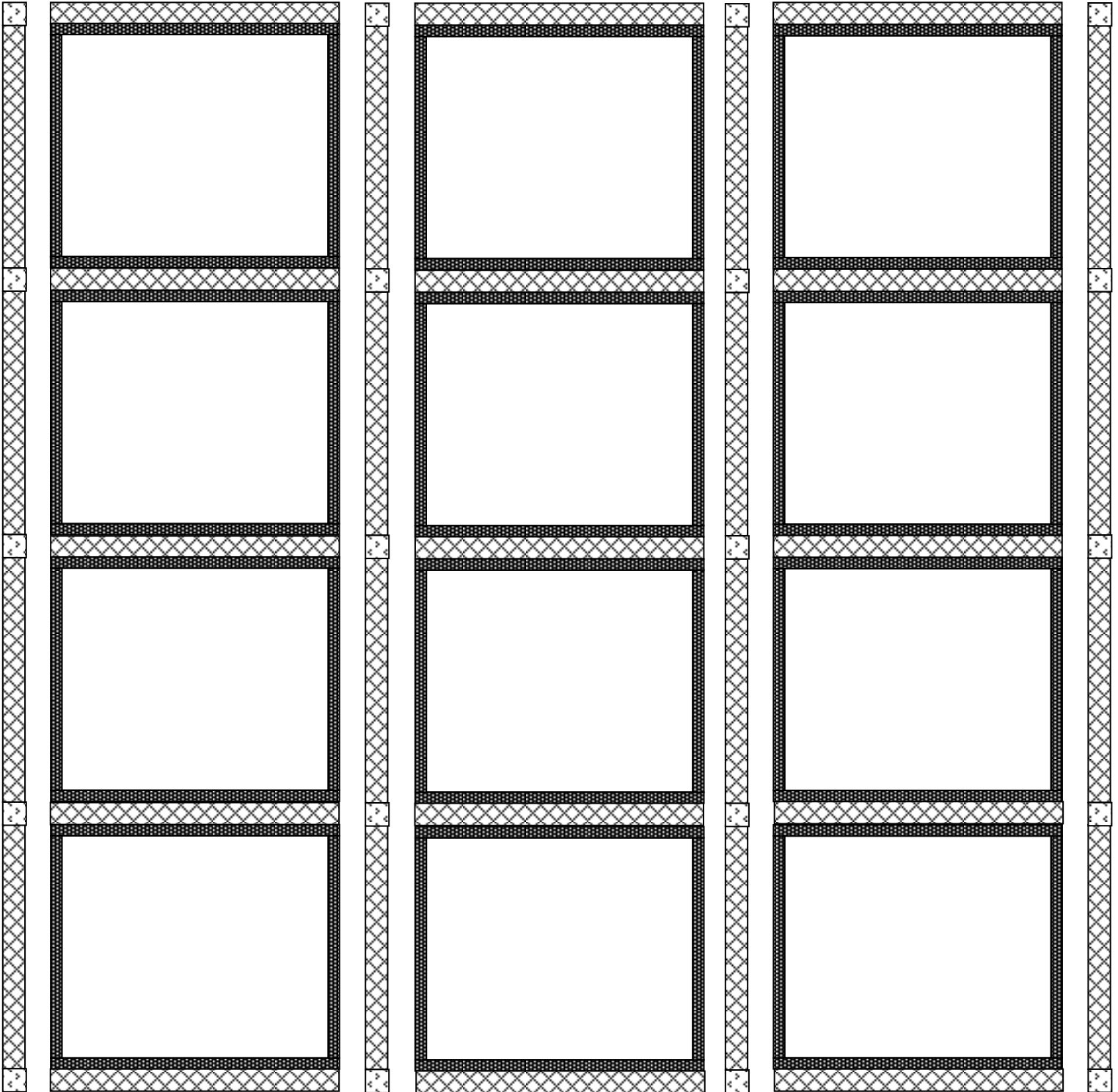
Lay out the 12 Bordered Blocks to decide which block goes where.

Place a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $26\frac{1}{2}$ " Sashing piece on top of, below and between the blocks.



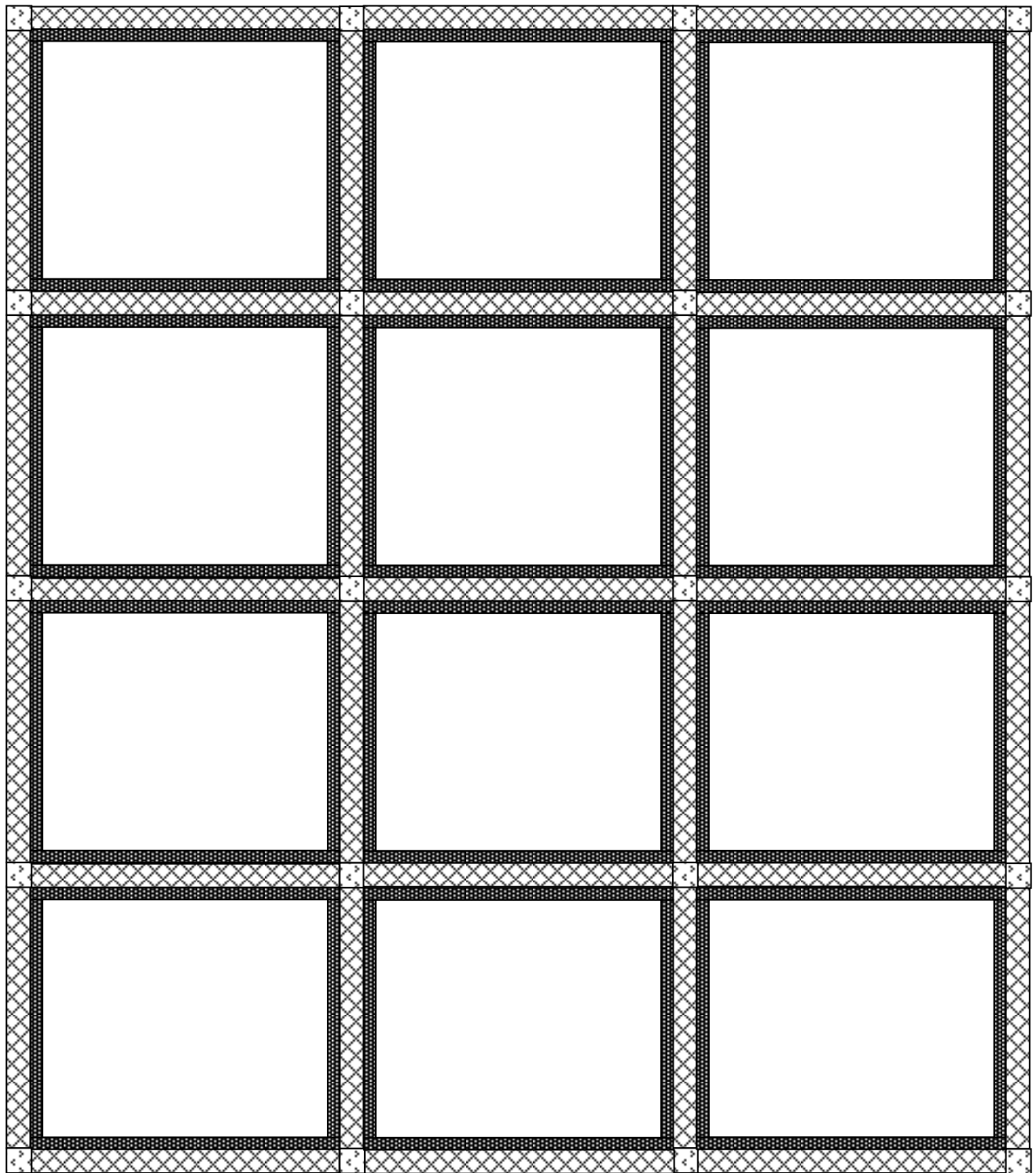
Sew the Columns together.

Sew together 4 vertical Sashing strips using 5 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Cornerstones and 4 - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $22\frac{1}{2}$ " Sashing pieces for each vertical Sashing strip.



Sew the Vertical Sashing strips to the Vertical Block strips.

Your quilt top now measures 86" x 98".



Backing: $2\frac{5}{8}$ yards of 108" wide OR 3 - $2\frac{5}{8}$ yards x wof sewn together ($7\frac{7}{8}$ total yards)

Batting: 92" x 104"

Binding: $\frac{3}{4}$ yard 10 cuts $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof

Quilt and Bind as Desired ☺
