

Read through the entire pattern before you get started.
Some decisions need to be made before cutting!

Cutting Instructions:



Block Borders: ($\frac{1}{4}$ yard each of 6 fabrics)

From each fabric cut 3 - 2" x wof

Subcut one strip from each fabric into 2 - 2" x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Subcut the other two from each fabric into 1 - 2" x 28"



Jewel Fabric: (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards)

Cut 4 - 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof

Subcut these into 1 - 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ "


Cut 1 - 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof

Subcut this into 1 - 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ "


Make the Block Borders:

Square up your block as close to 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " as possible.

Sew a 2" x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to each side of the large block.
Press toward the border.




Sew a 2" x 28" to the top and bottom of the block above.
(Center the piece if it is not quite long enough or too long.)
Press toward the border.



Square your block with borders to 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", centering the block.


Repeat to Border the other five Blocks.



Lay Out the Quilt Center:

Lay out the 6 Bordered Blocks to decide which block goes where. NOTE: the middle two blocks are turned sideways.

Place a $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 20\frac{1}{2}''$ Jewel Fabric in the four corners and the $20\frac{1}{2}'' \times 26\frac{1}{2}''$ Jewel Fabric in the middle.




Sew each of the three rows together.

Row 1 sewn together measures $22\frac{1}{2}'' \times 64\frac{1}{2}''$.

Row 2 sewn together measures $26\frac{1}{2}'' \times 64\frac{1}{2}''$.

Row 3 sewn together measures $22\frac{1}{2}'' \times 64\frac{1}{2}''$.

Sew Row 1 to Row 2 and then sew that to Row 3.



Your Quilt top now measures $64\frac{1}{2}'' \times 70\frac{1}{2}''$.

Backing: 4 yards

Batting: 72" x 80"

Binding: $\frac{5}{8}$ yard 8 - $2\frac{1}{2}''$ x wof

Quilt and Bind as Desired ☺
