



Instructions by Debbie Balagia

Supplies:

- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of fabric

Directions:

1. Finish off all the edges of the $\frac{1}{2}$ yard piece of fabric, ex: narrow hem, serge, rolled hem.
2. Fold fabric in thirds. *Note: each side has a fold and a hemmed edge.*



3. On one of the short sides you will stitch the top layer and bottom layer together. Do not catch the middle layer in the stitching.



4. On the other short side you will stitch the second layer and the bottom layers together along the edge.



5. Lay the piece on a flat surface and on the side common with the fold at the end measure 3" along the folded edge and along the stitched edge. Draw a line connecting these two points and stitch on line to create boxed corners. Turn bag inside out and tie the two loose ends into a knot and voila you have a bag!!

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
