Read through the entire pattern before you get started.

Some decisions need to be made before cutting!

Cutting Instructions:



Black Fabric: ($2\frac{1}{4}$ yards)

Block Borders: cut 12 - 3" x wof

Subcut four strips each into 2 - 3" x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " to make a total of 8

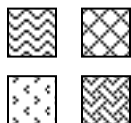
Subcut the other eight strips each into 1 - 3" x 30" (for a total of 8)

and 4 - $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares (for a total of 32 squares for the pinwheels)

Pinwheels: cut 2 - $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x wof

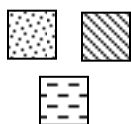
Subcut these into a total of 24 - $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

Quilt Top Borders: cut 7 - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof



Colors A (purple), B (green), C (pink), D (teal) ($\frac{1}{4}$ yard each): cut 1 - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof

Subcut each strip into 1 - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $28\frac{1}{2}$ " and 4 - $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares



Colors E (yellow), F (orange), G (blue) ($\frac{1}{8}$ yard each): cut 1 - $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x wof

Subcut E strip and F strip into 14 - $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

Subcut G strip into 12 - $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

Make the Block Borders:

Square up your block as close to $20\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " as possible.

Sew a 3" x $20\frac{1}{2}$ " to each side of the large block.

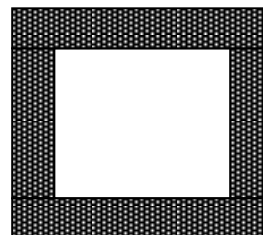
Press toward the border.



Sew a 3" x 30" to the top and bottom of the block above.

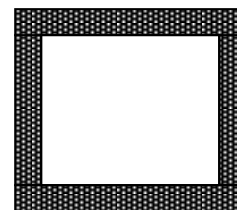
(Center the piece if it is not quite long enough or too long.)

Press toward the border.



Square your block with borders to $24\frac{1}{2}$ " x $28\frac{1}{2}$ ", centering the block.

Repeat to Border the other three Blocks.



Lay Out the Quilt Center:

Lay out the 4 Bordered Blocks and the Color A, B, C, D $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 28\frac{1}{2}''$ strips.

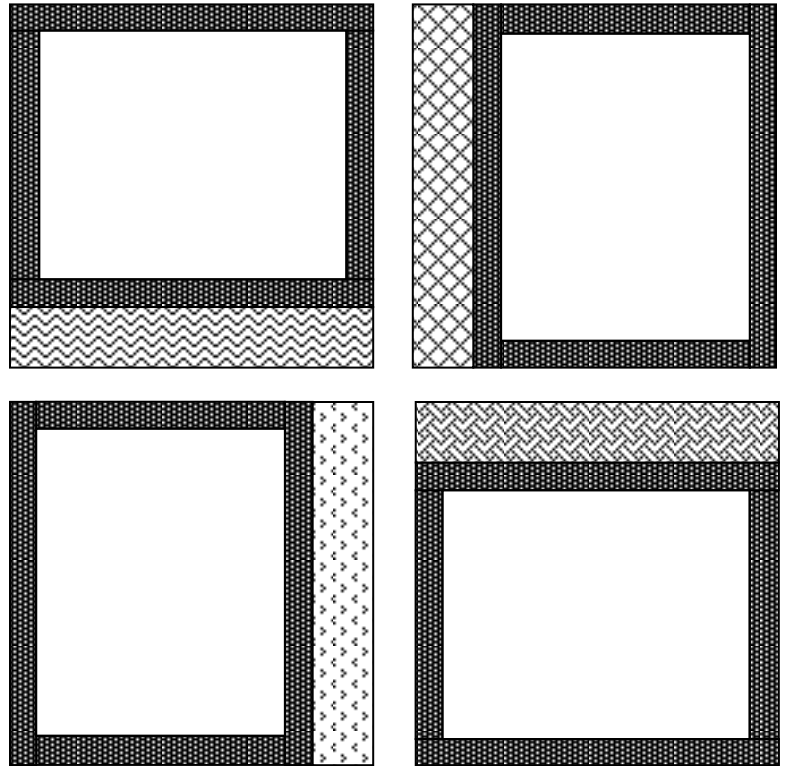
NOTE: Two blocks are turned sideways.

Sew the Color A $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 28\frac{1}{2}''$ strip to the bottom of the upper left block.

Sew the Color B $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 28\frac{1}{2}''$ strip to the left of the upper right block.

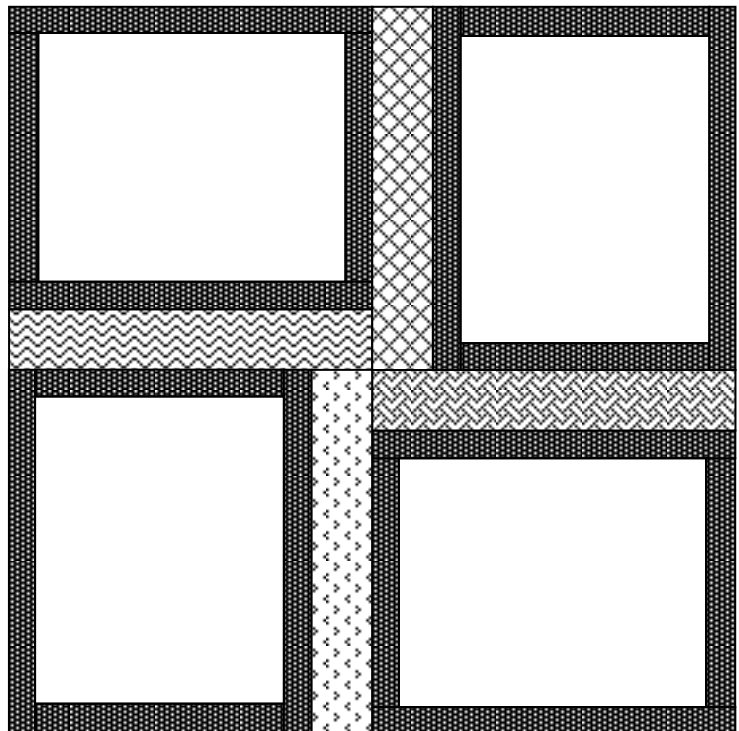
Sew the Color C $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 28\frac{1}{2}''$ strip to the top of the lower right block.

Sew the Color D $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 28\frac{1}{2}''$ strip to the right of the lower left block.



Sew the 4 Blocks together.

This now measures $56\frac{1}{2}'' \times 56\frac{1}{2}''$.

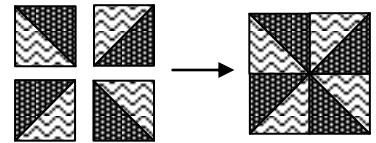


Make 112 Half Square Triangles into 28 Pinwheels:

Make 8 HST using 4 Color A and 4 Black Fabric $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.



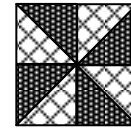
Make 2 Color A Pinwheels



Make 8 HST using 4 Color B and 4 Black Fabric $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.



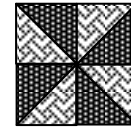
Make 2 Color B Pinwheels



Make 8 HST using 4 Color C and 4 Black Fabric $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.



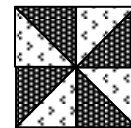
Make 2 Color C Pinwheels



Make 8 HST using 4 Color D and 4 Black Fabric $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.



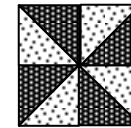
Make 2 Color D Pinwheels



Make 28 HST using 14 Color E and 14 Black Fabric $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.



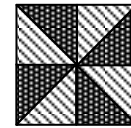
Make 7 Color E Pinwheels



Make 28 HST using 14 Color F and 14 Black Fabric $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.



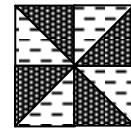
Make 7 Color F Pinwheels



Make 24 HST using 12 Color G and 12 Black Fabric $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.



Make 6 Color G Pinwheels



Sew 14 Pinwheels together to make the top row of Pinwheels.

The order I used is: Pinwheel E, F, A, G, E, B, F, G, C, E, F, D, G, E



Sew 14 Pinwheels together to make the bottom row of Pinwheels.

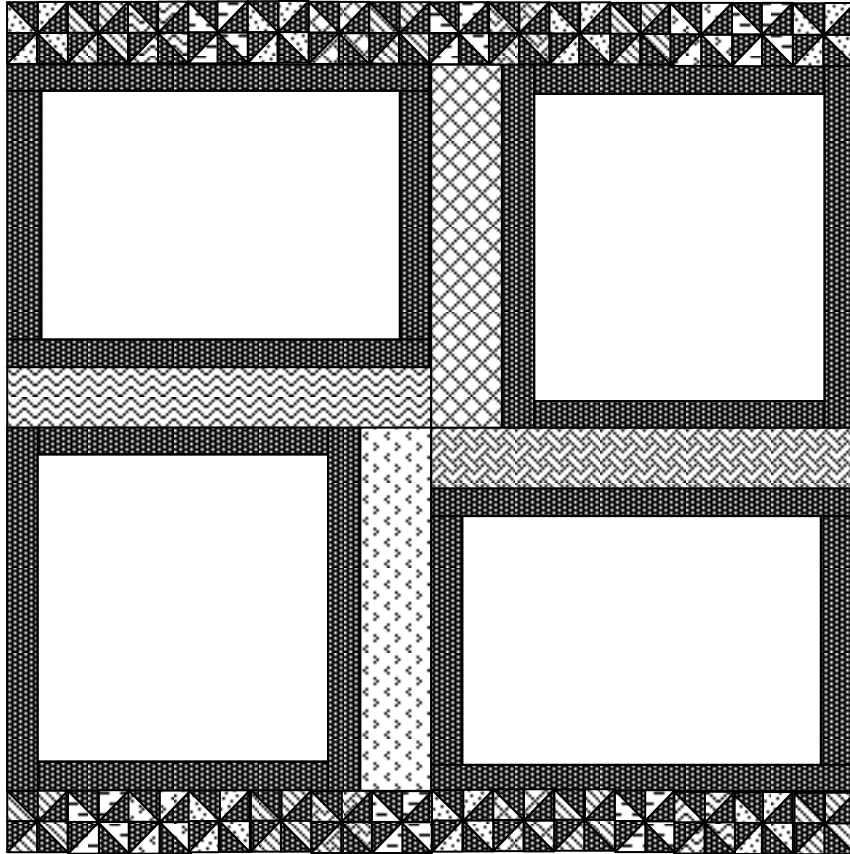
The order I used is: Pinwheel F, G, D, E, F, C, G, E, B, F, G, A, E, F



Build the Quilt Top:

Sew the top row of Pinwheels to the top of the Quilt top.

Sew the bottom row of Pinwheels to the bottom of the Quilt top.



Your quilt top now measures $56\frac{1}{2}'' \times 64\frac{1}{2}''$.

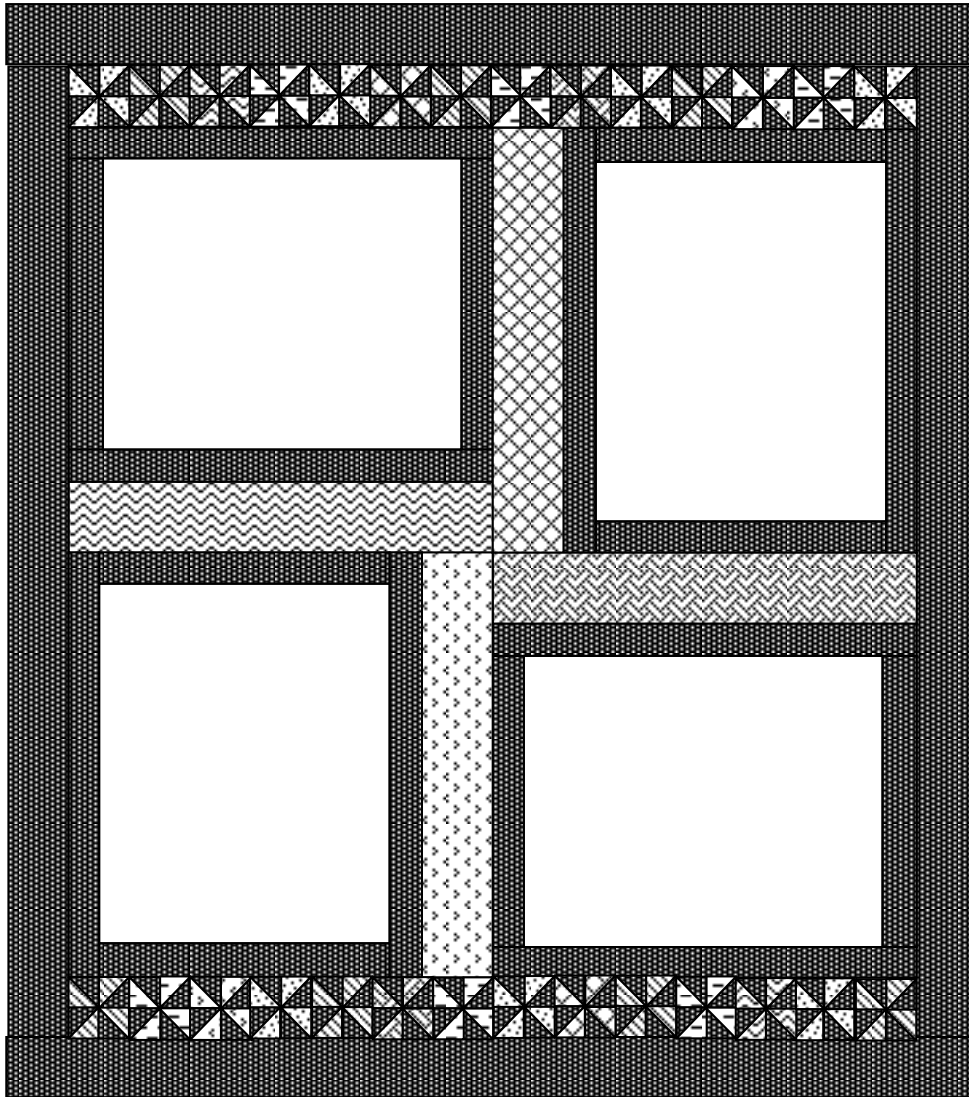
Make your Borders:

Sew your 7 Border strips together, end to end.

Cut 4 pieces $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 64\frac{1}{2}''$. OR, cut your pieces as you go by measuring your quilt centers.

Sew one piece to each side of your quilt top. Press.

Sew one piece to the top of your quilt top and one to the bottom of your quilt top. Press.



Your quilt top now measures $64\frac{1}{2}'' \times 72\frac{1}{2}''$.

Backing: 4 yards

Batting: 72" x 80"

Binding: $\frac{5}{8}$ yard 8 - $2\frac{1}{2}''$ x wof

Quilt and Bind as Desired ☺
